

# FARLAM PARISH COUNCIL

## Guidance for users of this Play Area

Farlam Parish Council will be opening this Play Area from 15<sup>th</sup> July 2020. To ensure you are ready to use this play area safely, please read these simple instructions that the Parish Council are asking you to follow:

1. Parents & guardians must read this guidance and ensure their families follow it carefully for the safety of their children & others.
2. Children **MUST be accompanied by an adult.**
3. The equipment is checked regularly (weekly) for damage, wear & tear, but it is NOT sanitised or disinfected.
4. This is shared, publicly accessible equipment, used at your own risk.
5. Do not consume food or drink in the play area.
6. Do not use this equipment if you or any member of your household has coronavirus symptoms or are self-isolating.
7. Make sure you have hand sanitiser with you before you enter this play area.
8. Encourage everyone in your family to wash their hands with hand sanitiser regularly and as a minimum before & after using the play area.
9. Encourage children to avoid touching their faces.
10. You **MUST** maintain social distancing from others who are not in your household- current advice is to maintain at least 1m distance, but where possible 2m, or consider wearing a mask (not advised for the under 3's).
11. Some equipment can only be used by one child at a time whilst social distancing. Please check the signs on each piece of equipment. Please ensure your children wait at a safe distance if the equipment is in use or return later to use the equipment.
12. Try to avoid busy times.
13. If your family is wearing disposable PPE, you **MUST** take it home with you. **DO NOT LITTER.**
14. Wash your hands thoroughly for at least 20 seconds with water and soap when you get home.
15. **Failure to follow these guidelines may result in a review of the play area being closed.**

We hope you enjoy using this play area and thank you for helping to keep everyone safe by following these instructions.

This guidance may be updated as regulations and guidelines change, therefore we ask you to review this signage each time you access the play area.
